Excerpts from Section 51:

(1) Subject to the regulations, a Board shall provide for the transportation of a student to and from the site of the school in which the Board has enrolled the student, if the students resides at the distance from the site of that school to be determined by the regulations, with the attendance area established by the Board, and within the boundaries of the district or division.

(2) The Board shall be deemed to have complied with subsection (1) when transportation is provided on a route that is not

Re:	In-Eligible Student Rider Reminder

Under the provisions of Section 51 of the *School Act* as well as Student Transportation Regulation 250/98 of the *School Act*, it states "a board shall provide for the transportation of a student to and from the site of a school in which the board has enrolled the student if the student resides 2.4 kilometres or more form the boundary school."

The board reviews availability on the buses after the 3rd week of September each school year for in-eligible students (students who are under 2.4 kms from their boundary school). Upon review, if space is available, a student may be allowed to ride the bus as long as space is not required for students who are eligible for transportation.

Please note, permission is only granted to in-eligible students after the third week of September for each school year and is not automatically granted into the next school year.

If your child is in-eligible for transportation for the 2019-2020 school year please note the procedure as outlined below:

- 1. At the beginning of the school year you may call my office and request that your child/children be placed on a waiting list. I receive a high volume of calls during this time, so please leave a message with your request. It could take several days for me to return any calls that require a response, however please note that all requests will be recorded and may not need a return call. Email requests will also be accepted.
- 2. Space availability will be reviewed during the 3rd week of September.
- 3. Parents are welcome to call my office during the 4th week of September to see if there is space for their child/children. Preference will be given to students whose distance from their school is the furthest.
- 4. If your child/children are granted access to the bus, you will need to sign the required acknowledgement paperwork in person at the Board Office. Once that has occurred, the school and Transit will be advised and your child/children will then be given a bus pass.

Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page <u>https://lethbridge.schoolcashonline.com/</u> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps
 *For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name.
- b) Enter the School Name.
- c) Enter Your Child's Student Number (this can be found on the report card)
- d) Enter Your Child's Last Name and Birth Date.
- e) Select Continue.
- f) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*.
- g) Your child has been added to your account.

School Messenger Instructions for Parents/Guardians

Lethbridge School District 51 is pleased to introduce its student absence reporting system. This system makes it easier for you to report your child's absence, reduces the time it takes to verify student attendance, and allows staff to respond to unexplained student absences more efficiently.

This new absence reporting system is called **SchoolMessenger**. It allows you to report your child's absence quickly and conveniently in one of three ways:

All methods are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Therefore, absences may be reported ahead of time, e.g. Doctor or dentist appointment etc.

In addition, we will be using the SchoolMessenger automated notification system to contact parents whose child is absent when the absence was not reported in advance. SchoolMessenger attempts to contact parents at multiple contact numbers until the designated contact(s) is/are reached. If the system is unable to reach a designated contact within 25 minutes, office staff will follow up. If you report your child absent in advance using the SchoolMessenger website, app or toll-free number, you will not receive these calls.

Please note that accounts must be created using email addresses that we have on file in the office. Student update forms can be found in the school office, if you need to change/update any information.

To avoid waiting in line at public Influenza clinics in Lethbridge, parents have the option to book appointments for their children aged 6 months up to and including 4 years of age.

This option is only available in Lethbridge. Parents will be able to call to book on/after 16 SEPT 2019.

When parents call to book the appointment for a child within this age range, they will also have the option of booking additional appointments so they and their other children can get their influenza immunizations at the same time.
