Presentation on grade configuration for the new year (Staff Looping) – Presented by Teri

- In discussion with Teachers it was found Teachers' goals / desires for the school are:

increase school spirit;

create a sense of community;

increase parental engagement;

flexible schedule;

high expectations for learning & fun

In the school for grades 2-5, there are 2 classes of each grade, with 1 split class of 2/3 and 4/5.
What occurs with Staff Looping, is each year, the teacher moves between classes. For example, in 2022 teacher A teaches grade 2, then in 2023 teacher A would teach grade 3, then in 2024 teach grade 2/3.

- Benefits of looping – Teachers have a stronger support network; they can see kids grow over a 2-year period; etc.

- Obstacles: Not all teachers have taught both grades; would need to balance student needs & group of students; etc.

- Teri will be sending out a survey to all staff & parents.

- Kindergarten & grade 1 are not being considered in this Looping structure, without teacher's expressed interest.
