- Assurance Plan was presented to Board Executives last week.
- Inclusion looking at removing barriers that improve for all learners. Create a space where all people matter. Staff working through a book called "Trouble Makers"
- Achievement & Innovation Teri & Sharon met with all staff. From MiPI data it was noted there was struggles with addition & subtraction. Tools available in the school were provided to support students.
- Teri & Sharon's goals developing a school mission. Developing deeper thinking ways different ways of viewing / thinking of the same topic. Changing physical spaces such as rearranged the office. Ordered new staff room furniture to be able to sit & eat.
 Furniture there was from 1982. Paid for by the school out of reserves

BOOST – grade 2 & 3, and grade 1 update

- Division does have money to hire new teachers due to covid impact for grade 2-3. Teacher starting on Monday for 16 weeks shared with another school. Goal is to be intervention programs Mon-Thursday & alternating Fridays. Pulling from grade 2 & 3. 6 groups of 6 students pull out program / arranged by the same cohorts.
- Just because a student's results does not meet criteria doesn't mean they will / will not receive BOOST program. Data was used in conjunction with teacher's input. Letters will be sent out Friday / Monday
- Grade 1 testing will be in January. It is unknown when financial support for teachers to support Grade 1 will arrive.
- There will be testing again at the end of the year to see if BOOST funding had any difference.
- Park Meadows swag sale on now until November 21.
 - In past it was ordered online through SchoolCash Online. However, this year SchoolCash is adding a surcharge. Considering this and that the vendor has been the same for a few years, it was decided to go with a local Northside Business as a vendor. Orders are through vendor's site, with no surcharge. On November 21, the online store will close and the vendor will sort orders by teacher, saving administrative time. The swag will be delivered before Christmas break.
 - Teri noted sweatshirts have been bought for staff. This is being extended to School Council executive members in support of acknowledging community.
- Possible Dress up day in December: winter hat day, crazy sock day, red and green day, winter sweater day, pajama day – Exact dates will be on the school calendar
- Informal Christmas concert of some kind.
 - Every class will do a song of some sort, which will be posted / password protected. Done for the last week of school Dec 17.
 - Last year school council helped decorate & asking if will do again up by Dec 6. If fully vaccinated can do during the week when no one is in (Wed / Thurs). Decorations are available at the school. Caylee & Linda volunteered pending date.
- Professional Student (PS) level 1 students will be practicing 4 in total in kindergarten, grade 1, 3, and 4.

• Retiring staff member – Cathy Young Pine is retiring in EEP. Last year was in Parker Place. This year is in kindergarten. New staff will be in place for Jan 2022
