If your child is sick, please do not send them to school. Staying home when sick can significantly decrease the spreading of illness to other students and staff at the school. Staying home when sick is one of the most important ways we can protect our school community. Anyone who is exhibiting symptoms of illness, including fever, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, new or worsening cough, or shortness of breath, should remain at home until their symptoms have improved and they have been free of fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, and they feel well enough to resume normal activities.
