PERSONAL MOBILE DEVICE AND SOCIAL MEDIA USE IN SCHOOLS

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL:

<u>Kindergarten to Grade 5</u> - Personal mobile device use is not permitted during the entirety of the school day. This includes instructional time and non-instructional time. Use of social media platforms on Division networks is restricted to educational use only.

HIGH SCHOOL:

<u>Grade 9 to Grade 12</u> - Personal mobile device use is not permitted during instructional time. The use of personal mobile devices during on-instructional time is permitted subject to responsible use Use of social media platforms on Division networks is restricted to educational use only.

MIDDLE SCHOOL:

<u>Grade 6 to Grade 8</u> - Personal mobile device use is not permitted during instructional time. During non-instructional time, the use of personal mobile devices is discouraged and will be limitted and subject to responsible use. Use of social media platforms on Division networks is restricted to educational use only.

Thank you for your patience as we navigate the first few weeks of transportation. Taking the bus is new to most of us and there are bound to be a few challenges as we learn together. It is very important that your child knows what to do

and where to go when they arrive at school and exit the bus. It is also very important that all students know what to do at the end of each school day. Students are responsible for getting themselves on and off the bus, lining up at their designated door for the beginning of the day, and making sure they are on time to catch the bus at the end of the day. Please do not call the office everyday to tell us whether your child will be taking the bus or not, this needs to be arranged and communicated with your child prior to coming to school. Please remind your child that if they ever need help or forget what to do, they should come to the office or find a supervisor.
