If you live more than 1.6km away from Park Meadows School, please log into SchoolEngage and fill out the BUSSING REGISTRAION FORM 2025-2026. Even if you are opting out of using the bus, we ask that you still fill out the form. If you need any assistance, please contact the office.



Alberta Education has announced adjustments for the distance requirements for students accessing school bus service. For the 2025/2026 school year, Kindergarten to Grade 6 students who live **1.6 kilometres** or more from their designated schools will be eligible for school bus service. This represents a change from the current eligibility requirements of one kilometre for Kindergarten to Grade 6. Due to the changes in distance eligibility, students in Kindergarten to Grade 6 who resided between **1-1.59 kilometers** and were transported to their designated school in the 2024/2025 school year will no longer be eligible for transportation in the 2025/2026 school year.
